

ACCESS

38% of Exposure 2021 festival visitors described their limited engagement with the arts.

15% of festival visitors had never attended an arts exhibition or event prior to Exposure 2021.

23% of festival visitors stated they do not engage in the arts regularly.

Additionally, 33% of participants in the Exposure 2021 Portfolio Review had not had their work reviewed before.



DIVERSITY

Exposure 2021's programming expanded equity, diversity and inclusion.


